**Jacob has been central in developing chess club by teaching students and staff how to play the game. It has really brought people together and we are really happy with our new location and clock.**



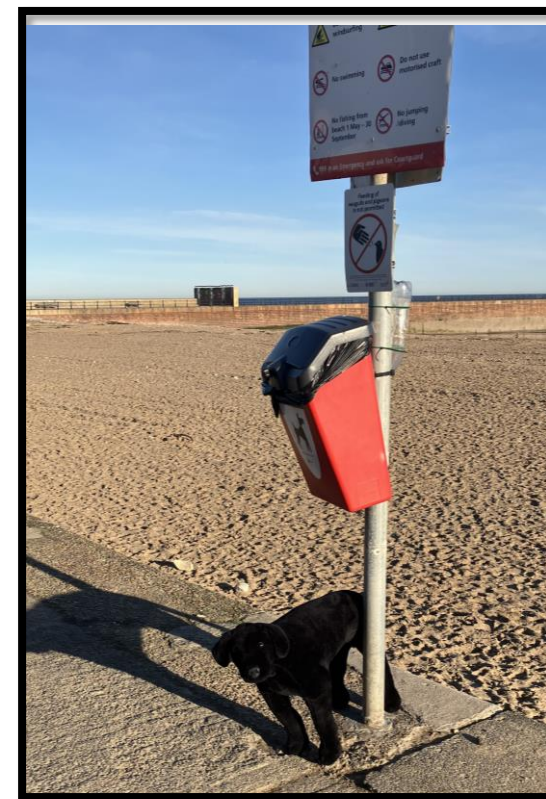
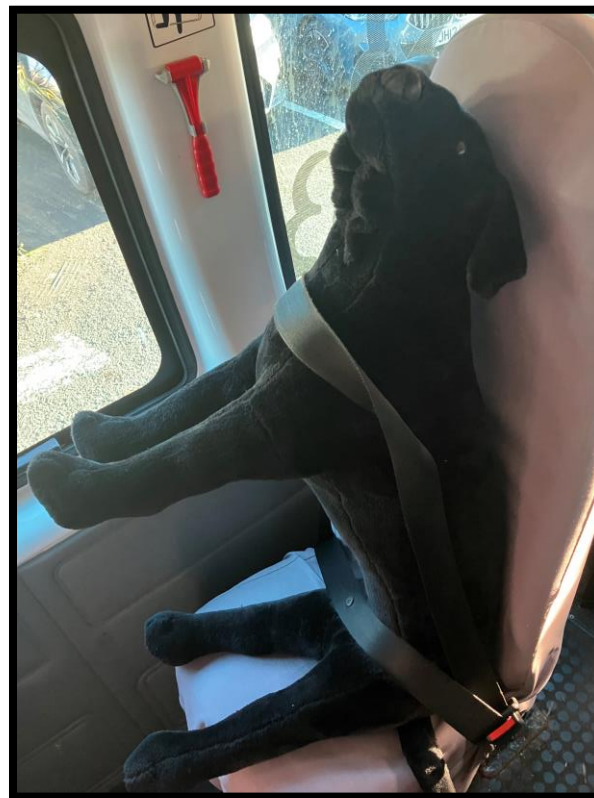
# Orienteering

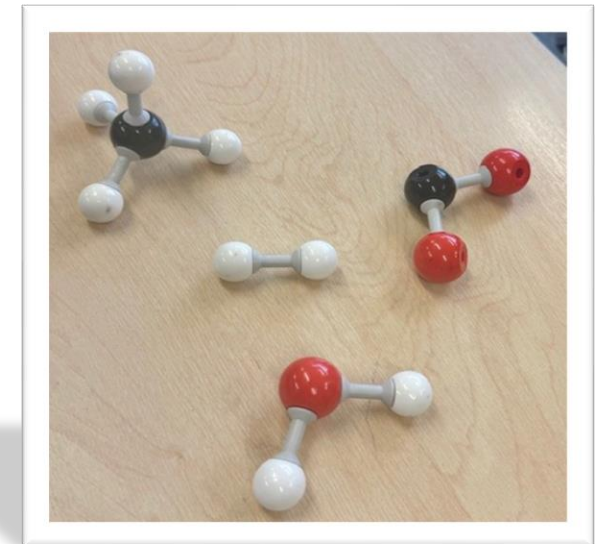
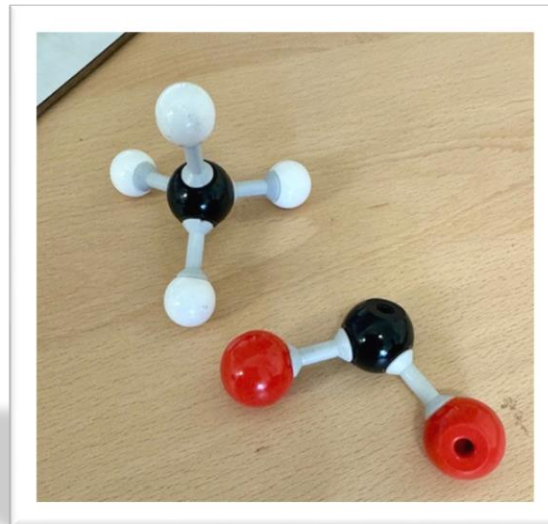
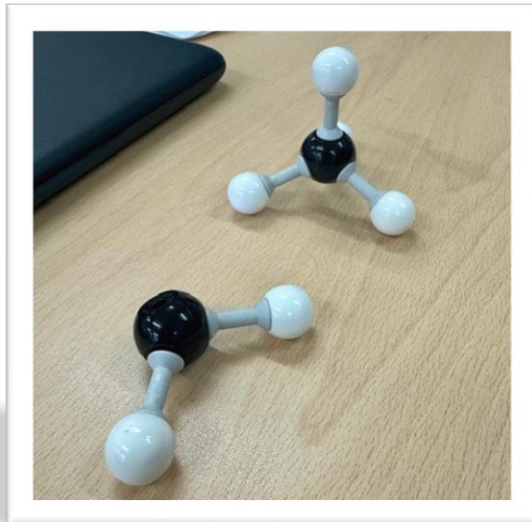
# LCA - Drumming
