
HELLO AND WELCOME TO KS3'S SECOND BLOG OF THE YEAR!

 We have continued to work hard and involve ourselves in all of the activities that are offered at Evolve.


 We are really looking forward to October half term despite enjoying our first half term back.

In the morning I do Fit 2 Learn. We go down to the field to play football and boules. It is a nice opportunity to spend time with students from all year groups.


Charlie was this week's boules Champion in PE. Well done Charlie!

Science - Circuits






We are learning about electricity in science. We have learned about components and have made series and parallel circuits in practical lessons.






Still Life by Charlie
